



As usual, arrive with a full tank. **Fun Fact:** Just before reaching our lunch stop we will pass by Lake Henshaw off to our North East. Lake Henshaw was constructed in 1923 (101 years ago) with the building of Henshaw Dam, an earth dam 123 feet (37 m) tall and 650 feet (200 m) long. It is owned by the Vista Irrigation District and used primarily for agricultural irrigation.

The HOPE Motorcycle Rally




